

GRANDPA'S

Grandpa joined the circus as a juggler. But every time he threw the balls up, they just fell to the floor beside him.





James is married to Linda, who is very smart -- she is a professor too.


They have a little girl, Payton, who is very smart -- she is in second grade.

Very soon Justin told Grandpa that it was time for him to go back home to his Daddy, Mommy, Sister, and to school.




Grandpa understood, but he started to be sad again.
